GUN & KNIFE SHOW RULES

1. **Vendors are required to stay both days for the duration of the show. Vendors who leave early may not be invited to participate in future shows.**
2. This is a no smoking facility.
3. No one under 18 years of age will be admitted unless accompanied by an adult and is under that person's supervision.
4. No dealing in parking lot or at entrance.
5. There will be no loaded firearms, magazines, or speed-loaders in the building, either on the tables or on one's person, with the exception of law enforcement officers.
6. Chemicals used to make explosive compounds are prohibited.
7. All firearms will have their actions tied open. Where that is impractical due to design, the action **MUST** be tied to make it inoperable and **conspicuous by visual inspection.**
8. All detachable magazines **MUST** be removed from a firearm before it is placed on a table.
9. Flintlock and percussion arms need not be tied.
10. Cartridge firearms for display only contained in a locked display case may remain untied.
11. Fully automatic firearms other than those displayed by law enforcement or military organizations, or parts to convert semiautomatic arms to fully-automatic are prohibited. **Dummy, replica, or registered Title II firearms must be accompanied by a clearly-readable sign stating that the item in question is not a machine gun.**
12. Any extended bayonets attached to firearms shall be fully in a scabbard (no exceptions). If a bayonet on a firearm has no scabbard, it shall either be folded against the stock or removed from the firearm. This applies to arms being carried as well as to arms that are on tables.
13. Firearm sales to persons prohibited by law from firearms ownership/possession are totally forbidden. Violators may be banned from future shows.
14. The sale of literature on the manufacture of unlawful explosive devices, silencers, full automatic firearms, booby-traps, and/or illegal terrorist tactics, etc. is prohibited.
15. All anti-Semitic, racist and hate literature is prohibited. The sale of targets depicting the likeness of American Politicians is prohibited. If any of the above or other related material is found, the owner of that material will be asked to remove it immediately.
16. Vendors are required to conduct NICS background checks and abide by those guidelines. Forms for background checks will be available and a LFD will conduct background checks for those who needing it done. (A small fee may apply)
17. Show security reserves the right to inspect all bags, packages or containers entering or exiting the show.
18. Vendors will wear their vendor identification with their name clearly visible.
19. Promotional material for distribution must receive the approval of the show manager before handing out or making available to the public.
20. In the event a vendor is asked to leave, all fees shall remain with the Grant County Fairground.
21. Vendor parking is on site next to the 3rd Street fence (except during setup and take down).
